Biography

Previous degrees include a Master of Sacred Music from Emory University in Atlanta, GA and a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration with a minor in music from Appalachian State University in Boone, NC. His principal teachers have been Michael Unger, Timothy Albrecht, and Florence Jowers. Matt is also a certified public accountant. Before pursuing advanced degrees in music, he worked as a staff accountant at the firm of Lawing, Matthews & Company, PA in Hickory, NC.
